Dear Parents/Guardians

Your son/daughter has made a successful start to this academic year and preparations have begun to prepare them for their final GCSE examination period. We are aiding them to be as successful as they can, accessing support where needed and allowing you to be fully informed of the expectations and requirements of this important time. With this in mind we have organised a **Revision Information Evening for Parents** combined with an opportunity to explore your child's next steps during the **Sixth Form Open Evening**. Both events are being held on the same evening **Monday 7 October 5-8PM**.

The evening is an opportunity to maximise home support for your child during this important period in their educational experience. The evening will begin at **5PM** and the main talks will feature in our main hall at **5:30-6:00PM** and repeated at **6:30PM-7:00PM**. The revision evening will be held in the art block and will feature revision stalls for each subject where you can purchase revision guides, discover key information regarding exams and discuss preparation and support with your child's Head of Department. We are also hoping the Kooth advice service and the National Citizenship Service will be in attendance. Our exams officers will be present in case you wish to discuss exam concerns and there is also the opportunity to drop in to visit Mr Davison in the library for Careers advice.

Further to this there will be the chance to sign up for any intervention classes that will be available during the October half term. An informative revision guide and a guide for parents are already available on Parentpay priced at £1.50 per booklet and can be collected on the evening if purchased in advance. We are also preparing a revision pack of knowledge organisers and a home learning book for your child to collect and take away on the evening, more information on how to best use the revision materials will be given within the talks on the evening.

Following on from attending the talk in the main hall and visiting the revision stalls there is opportunity to visit different department areas in the main school to consider your child's options for sixth form and find out key information about the requirements for application and course content.

This very important evening will be jam-packed with information to allow your child to prepare for success at examination level and to identify their next steps at the Giles Academy.
