Another busy week at Giles Academy with a fantastic range of activities, rewards and celebrations taking place across the whole school.

This week we have focused on our whole school reading initiative. Our Book Fair held in the library this week has been extremely busy. Students have been exploring the Book Fair throughout the week and have shown enthusiasm about the selection of books available with many purchases being made.

In addition to this on Thursday, our Year 7 students experienced DEAR Time – 'Drop Everything And Read'. This initiative encourages reading for pleasure at a designated time where students practice important reading skills. Year 7 students all engaged in a wide range of reading material and appeared to thoroughly enjoy it!

At the beginning of the week the River of Hope project was hosted at the school. This is an exciting project planned to be part of Her Majesty the Queen's Platinum Jubilee Pageant for students in Key Stage 3. The art-based cross-curricular project links schools around the world through the study of rivers with the final design being used in a flag to be part of the Jubilee parade. The students involved created an outstanding level of work with the visiting artist commenting on how talented and engaged the students were – well done to all involved!
