We have reached the final day in what has been an incredibly busy, but amazing academic year at Giles Academy!

Throughout this week, our respective Year groups have had the opportunity to enjoy their reward day through the Film Festival. I am pleased to inform you that our students thoroughly enjoyed and appreciated their complimentary treats/snacks, as well as having the chance to win some Love2shop vouchers in the Prize Draw and Super Prize Draw! We are very proud of our students and always look to reward them as much as possible. We are looking forward to the start of next academic year where all Trust schools will be launching the new rewards programme through our ASPIRE Challenge Passport.

Students across the South Lincolnshire Academies Trust took part in a STEM Dustbin Windmill Challenge in collaboration with Lincolnshire Institute of Technology. This team challenge is based on engineering and design and open to students in Year 9. Six of our Year 9 students attended the final following weeks of preparation to showcase their Turbine, competing against a number of other schools at the Lincolnshire Showground. The team had to provide a practical demonstration to a panel of judges, with the wind turbine being put through its paces to be able to withstand changeable winds from 10mph to 40mph. A fantastic final saw our Giles team 'VENUS' positioning overall 8th place. Well done to Andrew, Oakley, Lennon, Daniel, Millie and Zuzia for all of their hard work and commitment to the project with the valuable support from Mr Vrastiak and Mr Castley.

You may know Mr Cooper for many various important roles within his time at the school however today we have acknowledged that both Mr Cooper and Mrs Burrell (HR and Business Manager) have been at the school for 25 years in September. This is amazing service and commitment to the school! A special mention must go to Mrs Goodwin (Exams Officer) as she has worked at the school for an amazing 28 years! Congratulations to these three long serving members of staff, who I know have all supported the many students and families and staff who have attended Giles Academy.

As this is my last newsletter for this academic year, I would like to take the opportunity to reflect on some of the highlights from this academic year 2022/23.

- We ran into the start of the academic year with tremendous examination success in Summer 2022
  with our Progress 8 score being above national average and the highest progress score in the
  local area apart from Skegness Grammar School.
- Our student numbers have increased rapidly in all year groups, we have had the most admissions in the county and we are now **OVERSUBSCRIBED** in Year 7 for September 2023.
- In sports, we were finalists for the Contribution to Children and Young People Award for setting
  up the influence of golf for girls with Girls Golf Rocks! In addition to this, the PE department took
  part in a Cricket leadership programme and students were invited for their outstanding
  contribution to cricket to the Women's Ashes and interviewed for Sky Sports!

- The school Art and Design department continues to be a particular highlight in inspiring our students to produce fantastic creative mediums of art. There have been many invitations across the year to produce art work for events far and wide from the Iluminate lantern parade to an international project featured in an open gallery to producing a bespoke pieces for the local community, one of which will be unveiled at Skegness Train Station over the summer.
- Our school Bus Subsidy was launched to provide additional support for families with travel to and from school and we saw the arrival of the Food Pod for Year 7 students!
- There has been a variety of trips and visits to positively influence student school experience
  these have included Voice It, Tate Modern & Tate Britain Galleries as well as Peterborough
  Cathedral and Mosque visit.
- Students have actively supporting charities such as the overwhelming contribution to the Christmas Hamper event and supporting other international charities including the Turkey/Syria Earthquake appeal.
- Year 11 have had exam success with fantastic preparation, support and conduct during the exam process and a spectacular Prom to celebrate their time at Giles Academy!
- Reading Ambassadors, Buddies, Prefect Breakfasts... there has been far too much to mention!
- It has been an amazing year at Giles Academy.... and not forgetting the **Ofsted inspection** which validated the journey we have been on and the progress that we have made with the **Good with Outstanding Leadership** outcome, and the confirmation that our students are EXCEPTIONAL!


