Dear parents/carers and students,

It has been another fantastic week at Giles Academy!

Firstly, a huge thank you to the students who attended the Boston Town Remembrance Parade on Sunday. This follows on from the one-minute silence in school and laying a poppy wreath at Old Leake Church with school representatives on Friday. It was an honour to be a part of the town service for the first time in the local town and we were the only school represented from the local area. This week, all Year 8 students have experienced a Stay Safe Day in school - this is exposure to presentations delivered by specialists that supports students understanding important life skills and knowledge in respect to keeping themselves safe. The five presentations delivered to students covered Anti-social behaviour, Fire Safety, Online Safety, Alcohol & Drug awareness and Healthy Relationships. All students were extremely respectful in these sessions and the school received excellent feedback regarding the students conduct and organisation of the sessions.

Following the success of our Careers Day last week, we have continued with our careers visits. This week we have been joined by the British Army who have delivered a practical workshop. Students involved gained skills to support problem solving and team work skills to aid them in future career opportunities. There were also opportunities to ask questions regarding specialist career opportunities within the Army.
